Child and Youth Psychopathology

Brief description of course content (According to the programme's verification report)

Descriptors:

Child and youth psychopathology. Diagnosis of child and youth psychological disorders. Psychological assessment of children and adolescents. Psychological treatment of children and adolescents.

Contents:

Scientific principles of Child and Youth Psychopathology. Explanatory models and therapeutic approaches. Classification, diagnosis and assessment of child and youth psychological disorders. Basic behavioural repertoire disorders: elimination, food behaviour in childhood, and sleep. Specific psychological development disorders: motor behaviour, language and school learning. Generalized development disorders and intellectual disability. Attention deficit disorder, disruptive behaviour disorder and social problems. Emotional disorders in childhood or adolescence: mood and anxiety.

- 1. To know and understand the scientific principles of the discipline: historical evolution, concept, object of study, research methodology, theories and models.
- 2. To know the different types of classifications for child and youth disorders.
- 3. To know the different types of diagnosis for child and youth disorders.
- 4. To know the therapeutic options with regard to child and youth disorders.
- 5. To know the child and youth behavioural disorders: definition, classification, characteristics, frequency and distribution.
- 6. To know the child and youth behaviour disorders: diagnosis and assessment.
- 7. To know the child and youth behavioural disorders: explanation, types of treatment or intervention.
- 8. To understand the relationship existing between the different aspects of child and youth disorders (definition, classification, characteristics, diagnosis, assessment, explanation, treatment or intervention).
- 9. To know how to identify the requirements and demands of children and adolescents with psychological disorders in different areas of application for Psychology.
- 10. To know how to define objectives, select assessment techniques and treatment according to the requirements and demands of the children and adolescents with psychological disorders.

- Topic 3. Classification, diagnosis and assessment of child and youth psychological disorders. Psychopathological classifications. Diagnosis: Diagnostic approaches. Assessment.
- Topic 4. Disorders of the basic behavioural repertoire. Elimination disorders: concept (classification and diagnosis), explanation and intervention. Food behaviour disorders in childhood: concept (classification and diagnosis), explanation and intervention. Sleep disorders: concept (classification and diagnosis), explanation and intervention.
- Topic 5. Specific psychological development disorders. Motor behaviour disorders: concept (classification and diagnosis), explanation and intervention. Language disorders. School learning disorders: concept (classification and diagnosis), explanation and intervention.
- Topic 6. General development disorders. Development disorders: concept and classifications. Autistic disorder: characteristics, explanation and intervention. Asperger's disorder: characteristics, explanation and intervention. Intellectual/ Learning disability: characteristics, explanation and intervention.
- Topic 7. Attention deficit and disruptive behaviour disorders. Attention disorders and hyperactivity: concept (classification and diagnosis), explanation and intervention. Disruptive behaviour disorders (oppositional, challenging and anti-social): concept (classification and diagnosis), explanation and intervention.
- Topic 8. Emotional disorders in childhood or adolescence. Anxiety disorders in childhood and adolescence: concept (classification and diagnosis), explanation and intervention. Mood disorders in childhood and adolescence: concept (classification and diagnosis), explanation and intervention.
